



The Day after the Wall fell


Mrs. Marnali was only 3 years old, but was destined to meet Mr. Marnali from the former East, who moved across the border to West Berlin at age 14. Mrs. Marnali comes from a long line of a Berlin photographer family known in Germany and beyond and was a trained make up artist for international actors. Mr. Marnali was the favorite photographer of the celebrities and was allowed to work with all the famous actors as well. The art scene active today in Berlin from which Mr& Mrs Marnali come, attracts high society from all over the world and has influenced the two artists in their works.

Since 2017, the two Germans living on Mallorca have been staging the icons of PopArt culture in luxuriously furnished and, last but not least, humorously gripping PopArt works and sculptures.

They tell the glorious stories of the protagonists of PopArt in their own refreshing, colorful and new way. It's about Madonna, Lady Gaga, Brigitte Bardot, Karl Lagerfeld and even Choupette, the legendary fashion designer's famous cat. But these are not just mere illustrations that are as colorful as possible, but complex concepts on the basis of which new stories are told - with the help of the motifs themselves, but also with the forms and the materials and techniques used.

And that is exactly the secret of their success: The Marnali's tell stories. They combine content and form, art and technology into a new whole that is independent and definitely greater than the sum of its parts. Here Pop-Art becomes MarnaliArt.





Mr. & Mrs. Marnali - facts and background

Hardly any movement has influenced the culture of the 20th century as comprehensively-and lastingly as pop. Film, music, fine arts - the everyday reality of people shaped by mass media, advertising and consumption found its way into the different art forms. The works themselves also acquired a pop art character. And their creators became stars: artists like Roy Lichtenstein, Andy Warhol or Tom Wesselmann. They invented pop art as an art form. Mr. and Mrs. Marnali walk in their footsteps today. In the spirit of the great PopArt pioneers of the past, They translate PopArt into the world of the 21st century and create their very own MarnaliArt works.

The artist couple themselves come from Berlin and have been living in Mallorca with their three children since 2018. Their stage name "Marnali" is an acronym that combines the first names of the two artists Marko and Natalie. Marko was born in Halle, grew up in Berlin and later worked internationally as one of the most soughtafter photographers.

He worked with Lady Gaga, Johnny Depp, Karl Lagerfeld, Brad Pitt, Angelina Jolie to name just a few of the big stars. In his job he met his current wife Natalie, who comes from a well-known Berlin photographer dynasty. She is a trained make-up artist, graphic designer and stylist and has also been able to work with many stars from the film and fashion industry, such as: Kevin Spacey, John Goodmann, Heidi Klum, Eva Padberg and many more.

In 2017, Marko and Natalie brought their talents together and created the first pop artworks together based on his photographs while still in Berlin. A year later, the move to Mallorca took place.

The first vernissage on Mallorca of the two exceptional artists in 2018, in a gallery on Mallorca, was completely sold out after about 40 minutes. Further exhibitions followed, which have established themselves as one of the most popular art vernissages in Mallorca. The vernissages of the Marnali's are anything but boring, with big shows, DJs, live acts and top-class guests. Since 2019, the couple has been running the "Marnali PopArt Store" in the old town of Palma, where their works can be viewed and fans have the opportunity to meet the artist couple live.





MarnaliArt - art you can touch.


A real MarnaliArt work can always be recognized directly by the high quality of craftsmanship and by its very own depth and unusual feel. This applies particularly to the works created as panel paintings. Due to the generous use of materials, they actually have a haptic effect - accordingly: touching is desired here!

Only in this way, Their pictures can really be experienced. And what you experience is incredibly diverse. The Marnali's rely on mixed media. This means, among other things, digital printing, but also screen printing processes, and if the work requires it, a mix of both.

In addition to the various conventional colorants, crystals, gold, silver and even diamond dust, aluminum plates, plexiglas or mirrors serve as carriers. Sometimes the duo also works with heat in order to deform the material and give it an additional three-dimensionality.

The result: Marilyn Monroe in a surreal frenzy of colour, a last supper with supermodels as a crazy party in the Escape Room or a gigantic 100 dollar bill measuring 1.80 x 0.73 meters on which Donald and Daisy Duck portray a cheeky beanie Benjamin Franklin just say hello!
